

**Autumn Garden Market 2019 • Flowers**

Coreopsis	<u>Baby Sun</u>	Plant forms a low mound of dark green leaves, bearing many upright stems of large golden-yellow single daisy flowers for many weeks. Remove faded flowers regularly to encourage continuous blooming. Attracts butterflies.	golden yellow	A B
Coneflower	<u>Purple</u>	Oblong, 3- to 4-inch leaves form a dense foliage clump from which sparsely leafed flower stems produce showy ray-like flowers with a large center. Attracts butterflies and bees.	rosy purple	A B
Milkweed	<u>Butterfly Milkweed</u>	Attracts butterflies, especially Monarchs, with its vibrant color. This beautiful perennial is both a nectar source and a host plant where butterflies lay eggs.	orange	A B
Lobelia - Cardinal flower		A stunning addition to a woodland garden as the plant likes some shade and a moist soil. Flowers attract butterflies and hummingbirds.	red	A B
